



WCA 2012 PHOTO CONTEST

REGULATIONS

The World Photo Contest for anaesthesiologists will take place within the 15th World Congress of Anaesthesiologists – WCA 2012.

The selected photographs will be exhibited throughout the promotion of the congress, and during the congress at the Convention Center "La Rural".

Executive Committee: The Organizing Committee designates Dr. Bokser and Dr. Enrique Bernardo Lastiri, FAAAR honorary members, as Executive Committee to develop the regulations and other activities related to the Photo Contest.

Participants: Registered delegates for WCA 2012 will be able to participate.

Topics: categories to be entered:

- 1) My workplace
- 2) My country.

Only four (4) photos may be submitted for each category.

The responsibility for any third party claim in this regard shall be borne by the participant.

Each delegate should indicate the category of each photo.

Photographic material:

Photographs must be original and must not have been published or awarded in any other contest.

Photographic images will be evaluated (classical photography, digital, operated by computer, assembly, etc).

The images must be sent in JPG format and must be sized to allow printing to a size less than 30 x 40 cm (minimum of 2666 pixels on its longest side) and a resolution not less than 200 dpi. Do not include signatures, frames and texts on the images. Participants must identify their photos with a title and add a brief technical and thematic description, including the place where the photos were obtained.

Registration: Participants must register completing the photo contest registration

form which is available to download from the congress website at www.wca2012.com, with the following personal information: full name, address, country, email and working place. The registration form should be sent by e-mail to pictureswelcome@wca2012.com

Information regarding participation in other previous photo contests, awards or any other relation with the photography, is optional.

Photo Submission: The photos should be sent only by e-mail to: pictureswelcome@wca2012.com. The deadline for submission is **October 31, 2011.**

Four (4) photos per category and a total of eight (8) may be submitted.

Participants must agree to accept its use without any payment of rights, in the national and international promotion of the WCA 2012, during the congress and in any instance after the end of the congress, with the only requirement being to mention the author's name and title of the photo and to maintain the author's Intellectual Property Rights. Participation in this contest implies acceptance of the terms and conditions thereof, without objection. The Organizing Committee shall not be responsible for any expenses incurred by authors.

The mere submission of photos involves: a) knowledge of these rules, b) an affidavit of authorship, originality and ownership of the participant photographic work.

Jury: The Organizing Committee will appoint Jury members who, according to their professional approach, will be solely responsible for selecting the winning photos. Considerations, judgments and decisions of the Jury are final and will be announced on December 2011. The winning photos will be announced on the congress website at www.wca2012.com

Awards: four awards will be assigned per category and will consist of crafts from Argentina and the corresponding certificate of award. Notification of awards will be sent to the authors' email address and published on the website.

The exhibition of photographs, will take place during the congress at the Convention Center La Rural and on the congress website.

Others: WCA2012 Organizing Committee and the Members of the Jury shall have jurisdiction to resolve any situation not contemplated in these regulations. The organizers reserve the right to modify these terms and conditions. Any questions regarding the interpretation of these Regulations shall be settled exclusively by the Organizing Committee and its decisions are final.

Contest organizers disclaim all liability for the use that would give anyone else to the winning photos and / or third party claims related to intellectual property rights of the photographic material.
